
Chip Carving Pattern: Fir Holiday Rosette

The Fir Holiday Rosette chip carving pattern is designed to be used as an ornament or a coaster. Recommended basswood board is at least 3/8" (1 cm) thick. Carving angle is up to 55° on thin 1/4" (6 mm) boards. The rosette on the left is easier to carve as there is space between fir trees. For a different effect, you may skip carving the tree trunks and/or color all or some trees with paint or colored pencils.

Tip: Start chip carving the pattern with the largest chips. Find more tips at <u>readNtry.com</u>.
